New Hampshire Legislative Report

Brian Rater of the Brookline Democrats has opted to re-engage in putting together the weekly Legislative Report (which will be posted to the Hollis Dems website each week [here](#)). Thank you Brian!

A self-avowed policy-wonk, Brian reviews important bills and actions by our representatives and chronicles them to help us hold them to account. This report holds a wealth of information on how you can take effective action on bills that matter to you.

If you want to receive the report each Monday with a recap and preview of

Scott King, wrote to the Senate. "Mr. Sessions has used the awesome power of his office to chill the free exercise of the vote by black citizens in the district he now seeks to serve as a federal judge," King wrote. "This simply cannot be allowed to happen."

Senator Steve Daines warned Warren not to violate the seldom used Senate rule 19 against "impugning the motives" of a fellow senator. Despite Senator Warren's protestations that she was reading the words of others made prior to Sessions becoming a senator, the Senate voted 49-43, along party lines, to confirm that Warren had violated Senate rules, and forbade her from speaking.

Unable to speak on the Senate floor, Warren quickly took advantage of social media and read King's letter live on Facebook, tweeted, and was interviewed via phone by Rachel Maddow on MSNBC.

Majority Leader of the Senate Mitch McConnell's quote about the incident went viral, perhaps


