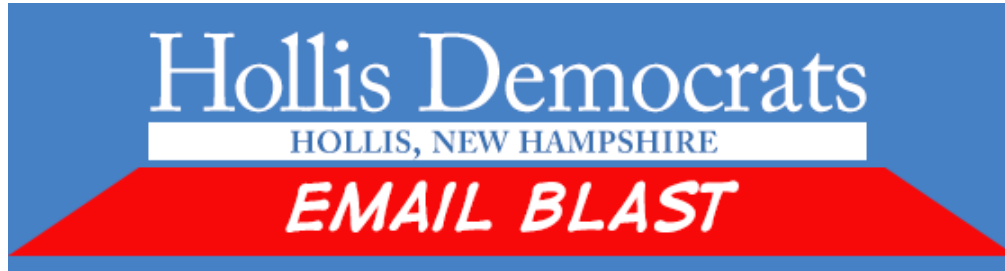

Interested candidates for Democratic offices who are registered 'Undeclared' have until May 31st to switch their affiliation with the Hollis Town Clerk in order to be eligible to run for Democratic office.

- The dates for filing for open offices this year are: June 1st through June 10th 2016 - State Rep. candidates may file at the Town Clerk's office.
