MEDICAID (SB413) Did your legislators vote to expand Medicaid coverage to 50,000 Granite Staters under the federal Affordable Care Act? (Senator Gilmour is a sponsor of this bill; bill passed the Senate 18-5; bill passed the House 202-132; bill was signed into law by Governor Hassan.)

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DEATH PENALTY (HB1170) Did your legislators vote to **repeal** New Hampshire's Death Penalty? (The House passed the bill 225-104; the bill was defeated in the Senate 12 – 2, so Governor Hassan had no opportunity to sign).

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BACKGROUND CHECKS (HB1589) Did your legislators vote to require background checks for firearm sales at gun shows, flea markets, and other commercial gun sales? (Bill was defeated 177-175 in the House, so the Senate did not vote on it.)

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NON-DISCRIMINATION CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT (CACR17) Did your legislators vote to add "sexual orientation" to the list of categories where discrimination is prohibited in Article 2 of the NH Constitution? (Bill passed the Senate 23-0 and will be voted on in the House.)

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EDUCATION (HB1508) Did your legislators vote to **terminate** state participation in the Common Core educational standards? (The House defeated the bill 201-138, so the Senate did not vote on it.)

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REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH (HB 1501) Did your legislators vote to impose extensive licensing requirements on abortion providers, making it practically impossible to provide abortion services outside of a major hospital?
